# The Organization of Distance Learning 16 March - 30 March 2020

- Structured and guided learning must continue.
- The students should follow their regular routines as much as possible. Each day there should be learning time, resting time and physical activity time.

The students are familiar with the platforms that we are using, they were also instructed today. Now we can test together how our educational technology skills and ideas work in practice! Please be patient and allow for the system a couple of days to work in.

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### Instructions for Grade 1 - 3

- The assignments for each day are inserted into the e-diary (Stuudium is.ope.ee) by 9 a.m. by the class or subject teachers.
- The students will complete the assigned tasks by the end of the same day (20:00 latest). The parents may help and guide the students with their work.
- The parents will structure the distance learning day according to the family's possibilities, you are not expected to follow the school's timetable (e.g. if parents work in the morning, the tasks can be completed in the afternoon etc).
- The teacher will notify if, how and when the completed tasks are checked (e.g. asks to send a photo of the completed worksheet).

### Instructions for Grade 4 - 9

- The students will follow the timetable that has been modified for the distance learning period.
- Distance learning days will start at 9:00 and end as scheduled in the timetable.

- Students will log into their e-diary (Stuudium is.ope.ee) in the morning. The teacher will
  insert the distance learning work into the e-diary shortly before every lesson. The tasks
  will appear under "Homework" section, but will be done during the distance learning
  lesson (e.g. if it says in the timetable that Geography for grade 7 is at 12:00 12:45, the
  student has to check the e-diary at 12:00 and start the lesson by following the
  instructions given in the e-diary).
- The teachers will use different digital platforms, usually in real time (e.g. Google Classroom, Google drive, Zoom), but the starting point of each lesson is always in the e-diary.

## • Important about the Timetable!!!

- Lesson times differ from the regular ones. The lesson times below are valid for the next two weeks.
- Lessons in blue must be followed in real time, the teacher will be online via one of the platforms and is waiting for the students to join the class or start the task.
- The tasks for the lessons in black can be completed any time during the day (until 20:00).
